Entry Requirements

- Australian Year 11 or equivalent (for International Students)
- Minimum IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent* OR A minimum of two (2) years of study at an AQF Level 4 or higher completed in Australia
- Minimum age of 18 years

Assessment

Assessments include case studies, group work, role plays, written short answer questions, practical demonstrations, and a work placement portfolio.

Work Placement

Students must complete **160 hours** mandatory placement for the work-based training to complete this program. TPC will facilitate work placement assistance for students.
